Regulation 25 Notice

TO : WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

We The Well Station Ltd do hereby give notice that it is our intention to apply to Brighton & Hove City Council for the variation of a premises licence to use or permit the use of premises known as 92 Goldstone Villas BN3 3RU. For the following licensable activities which it is proposed will be carried on, on or from the premises.

The proposed variation seeks to amend the times for off-sales of alcohol to 23.30 everyday, to add on sales of alcohol 12.00 to 23.30 everyday and to add late night refreshment, live and recorded music 23.00 to 23.30 everyday.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application, the maximum penalty for which a person is liable on summary conviction is an unlimited fine.
