Regulation 25 Notice

for the following licensable activities/ proposed variation which it is proposed will be carried on, on or from the premises:

Variation to the premises licence to permit and regulate under-18 and mixed-age events, including associated safeguarding and operational conditions.

a brief written statement of the grounds of his/her objection. The register and records of applications may be viewed at the above council office during normal office hours; summaries are available via www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/licensing.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application, the maximum penalty for which a person is liable on summary conviction is an unlimited fine.
